### Guidelines:

- These articles will be written by the editors and individuals they invite to work with them; uninvited submissions will not be accepted.
- Artwork will be selected with an international scope in mind.
- The Editors will work with the institution housing the artwork to obtain permission to reproduce it in print, in the online journal, and via social media for promotional purposes.
- Artwork should be provided as follows for publication purposes:
  - Minimum resolution of 300 dpi
  - 1 column = 87.50mm; 2 columns = 180mm
  - Color System: CMYK
  - Format: High res JPG, Tif, PDF, PNG (no .gif files)
  - Permissions documentation should be provided with the image.
- The figure legend should include proper attribution of the artist, name of the work, institution housing it, and permissions.
- The text may be up to 1,000 words (excluding references).
- The text may include 5 or fewer references.

### In addition:

- The Editors will engage an art historian to co-author these articles.
- The Editors will engage a fellow to work on the project as they see fit.
